

### Production Battle Drive Is Concluded

But the Movement Will Be Continued Late Into the Year

#### APATHY ASSAILED

Public Urged to Catch Up With Army in Service Spirit

The intensive campaign for the Battle of Production conducted all last week by the Onondaga County League of Women Voters was concluded yesterday afternoon but the movement will be carried on throughout the summer and even longer.

The committee feels that while many were aroused to the need of extraordinary effort to produce defense goods, there is still need for more work.

"We feel we have made a beginning," said Mrs. M. E. Cummings, president of the Onondaga County League. "But we'd like to awaken all citizens to the importance of winning this battle on which so much depends. We have to produce the goods and we have taken seriously the fact that there is a national emergency."

Several commented yesterday on the campaign and its purpose. "One of my boys is a flying major in the Army," said Daniel Shea of Selective Service Board 465. "My boy says there is one weak link between what the Army is and what it would like to be—and that is the people. They don't seem to realize that since the last war the Army has improved incalculably in its training and morale. If the public gets behind this Battle of Production 100 per cent it is also getting behind these boys of ours. When a football player thinks he is doing all he can—and then the coach gives him a good pep talk he goes back into the game and does twice what he thought he could. It's the same with production."

"Full defense production is the basis on which we must protect our free and independent American way of life," said Norbert C. H. Muench. "The public must awake to this necessity."

Mrs. Harry B. Kallett said she thought the people are beginning to realize the seriousness of the situation. "One of the great problems has been indifference on the part of the public and I am beginning to feel a change of attitude," she said.

"The public is now becoming very receptive to the idea that it must win the Battle of Production," Raymond Yackel said.

"It is reported the men of France have become too discouraged to try to redeem their nation but that the women of France are determined France shall not be permanently in slavery," said the Rev. George H. MacNish of Cleveland. "The women are cultivating this quality of winning this battle for democracy and men must do the same."
